construction a decision-making aid when it comes to sustainable and healthy living.

For builders, the environmental product declarations (EPD) in particular are further proof of sustainability for positive environmental properties and emission behavior of the materials, always with a view to the entire product life cycle. For a large number of the products, these EPDs are specified in the

sustainability data sheets which can be downloaded from the PCI and THOMSIT websites.

The PCI Group also attaches great importance to sustainability at the production sites. PCI Augsburg GmbH was one of the first companies in the construction industry to receive a certificate from the German Sustainable Building Council (DGNB) for the Augsburg site.
